HOW TO TELL THE TIME

IN ENGLISH, WE NORMALLY ONLY TELL THE TIME IN 12 HOURS (NOT 24 HOURS)

INSTEAD WE USE 'AM' AND 'PM' TO SHOW IF A TIME IS IN THE MORNING OR AFTERNOON

AM

IN THE MORNING

PM

IN THE AFTERNOON

So in English:

3h = 3am

15h = 3pm

IF THE MINUTES ARE UNDER 30, WE USE PAST

8:23 = twenty-three minutes past eight

IF THE MINUTES ARE OVER 30, WE USE TO (THE NEXT HOUR)

8:42 = eighteen minutes to nine



A QUARTER

WHEN THE MINUTES ARE 15 OR 45, WE USE QUARTER PAST OR QUARTER TO



11:15 = <u>quarter past</u> eleven 11:45 = <u>quarter to</u> twelve

A HALF

WHEN THE MINUTES ARE 30, WE USE HALF PAST
