SIMPLE PAST TENSE

TO BE / TO HAVE

TO BE IN THE SIMPLE PAST TENSE

I was

You were

He / She / It was

We were

They were

TO HAVE IN THE SIMPLE PAST TENSE

Ihad

You had

He / She / It had

We had

They had

REGULAR VERBS

For all regular verbs you form the simple past like this:

SUBJECT



INFINITIVE VERB



'ED'



OBJECT

Examples:

I played football

He enjoyed the evening

For verbs that end in 'y', you change it to 'ied'
E.g. I reply -- I replied

For verbs that end in 'e', you just add 'd' E.g. I dance -- I danced

NEGATIVE FORM

To form in the negative:

SUBJECT



DID NOT / DIDN'T



VERB



OBJECT

Examples:

I did not play football He did not enjoy the evening We did not have the map This is correct for regular and irregular verbs

INTERROGATIVE FORM

To form a question in the past tense:

DID



SUBJECT



VERB



OBJECT

Examples:

Did you play football?

Did he enjoy the evening?

Did they have the map?

This is correct for regular and irregular verbs
