am able, is able, are able, can

Positive Present Tense Examples:

- I can go the market today.
- I am able to go to the market today.
- She can help us move today.

Negative Present Tense Examples:

- I cannot go to the market today.
- I can't go to the market today.
- We can't go to the part on Friday.

Positive Present Tense Examples:

- I am doing the laundry.
- I do the dishes everyday.
- He does many things at once.

Negative Present Tense Examples:

- I don't do anything on Sundays.
- They don't like going to the fair.
- She doesn't do much other than work.
