The 4 Seasons

• Fall or Autumn:

- The names fall and autumn mean the same season, although autumn is considered a little more formal.
- This is the season in between summer and winter when the leaves change and start falling to the earth.

• Winter:

- This it the coldest season of the year and is in between fall and spring.
- This is the main season for snow and is always associated with snow.


• Spring:


 This is the season in between winter and summer when the leaves start to grow back on the trees and it starts to get warm again.
