# Introduction

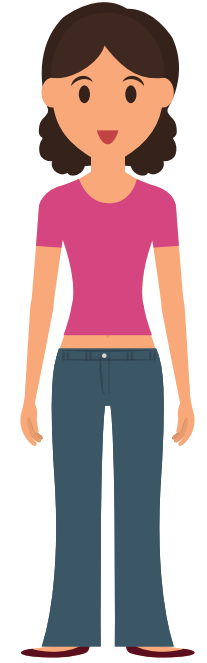


- Whether you would like to become a veterinarian, animal doctor, or not, it is still good to learn the names of at least the most common animals in English.

# The 6 Main Types of Animals

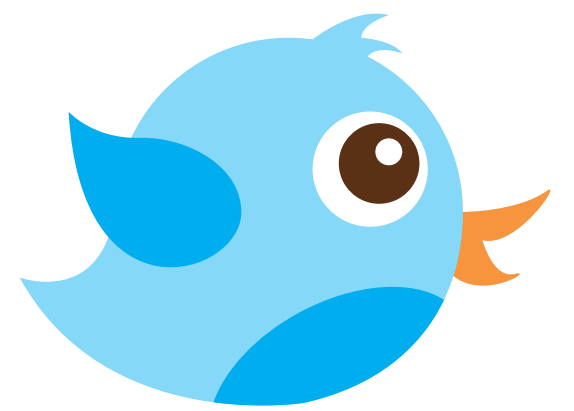
- Mammals:

- Give birth to live young (do not lay eggs).
- Usually have hair or fur.
- Humans are mammals.



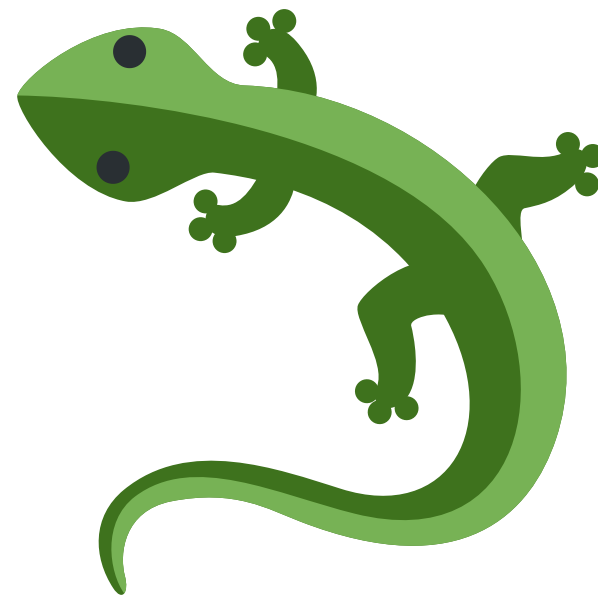
- Birds:

- Have wings and usually can fly.
- Lay eggs.
- Chickens are birds.



- Reptiles:

- Usually have scales.
- Lay eggs.
- Lizards are reptiles.



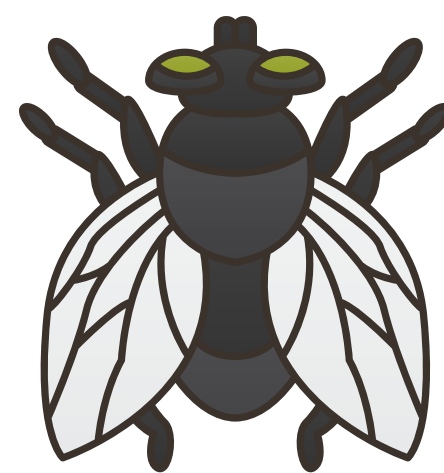
- Amphibians:

- Usually grow up under water and spend the rest of their lives on land.
- Frogs are amphibians.



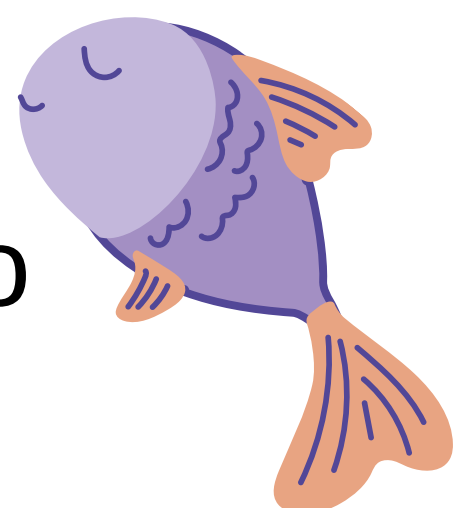
- Invertebrates:

- Do not have any bones.
- Insects are Invertebrates.



- Fish:

- Animals that live under water and do not breathe air.



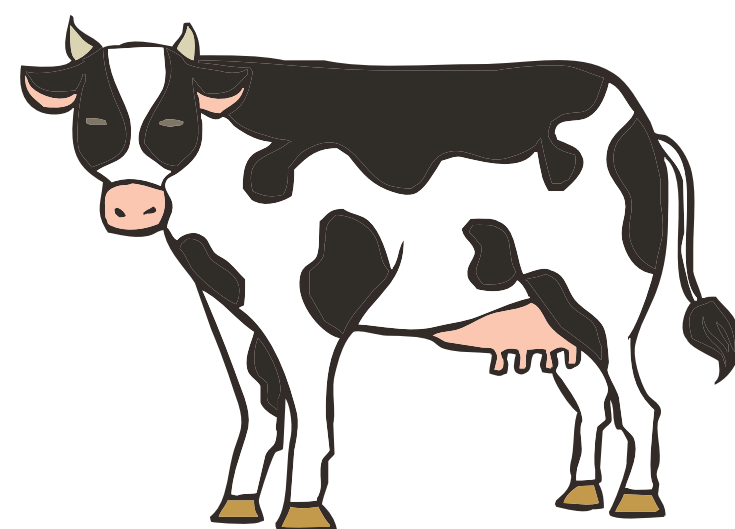
